_____ Lights

Assisting in positioning the lights for the scenes, moving them around on the set, and taking care to secure the lights and wiring in a safe way.

_____ Sound

Sitting still for periods of time to listen to and mix sound, and moving around with a boom (a movie-set microphone).

_____ Camera

Assisting the director of photography with the camera and equipment, and helping to keep track of film stock and scene takes.

_____ Production

This department oversees the entire set and does whatever is necessary to make things happen: making certain that things get done and that people are quiet on the set. This position requires a strong hand and an ability to interact with a wide variety of people.

_____ Grip

Securing cables and wires, and making certain that electrical power is readily available in a safe environment. This is the important job of this department.

_____ Make-up

This department prepares the actors for each scene, and works with them throughout the day on touch-ups. They are always readily available when the director needs them.

_____ Craft Services

Making certain that meals arrive for the crew, organizing the set-up, and replenishing drinks and snacks is the important job of this department.

_____ Art Department

This department works with props, decorations and furniture to transform a space into a physical location in the storyline of the film.

_____ Wardrobe/Costume

Working closely with the actors and director, this department organizes and prepares the clothes and accessories for each scene and assists the actors with getting ready for the scene.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:

- Specific filming dates are Saturday, September 25th and Sunday, September 26th. We will notify all Internship Program applicants of the filmmaking dates as soon as possible
 - This is an application process. By submitting this application your child is not necessarily guaranteed a position on the film set
 - To be fully eligible for consideration of this program your child must submit the permission form below fully filled out and signed by a parent/guardian along with their application
 - If your child is selected, Scenarios USA is not responsible for getting your child excused from activities (including but not limited to school, work and extra-curricular activities) in order to be involved in the filmmaking
 - If your child is selected, Scenarios USA is not responsible for your child's transportation to the film set or home from the film set but will be responsible for any travel that occurs during filming
 - If selected your child must commit to 2 full days on the film set
 - Meals are provided
 - Your child will be fully supervised the entire time that he or she is on the film set
 - Scenarios USA is not responsible for your child if for any reason he or she leaves the film set without the permission of their immediate supervisor
