What? This free workshop will show how learning about masculinity can help students meet the New York learning standards for English Language Arts, Social Studies, Health Education and Drama. We will also introduce teachers to the Scenarios USA *What's the REAL DEAL about Masculinity?* story, play and scriptwriting contest.

Workshop participants will receive a free contest kit, including a curriculum, 20 journals and 3 Scenarios USA short films. **Contest winners turn their story into a film with a Hollywood director; will be trained in public speaking and advocacy; and will receive \$500.**
